### *The Walk To Emmaus*

\*\*\*\*\*

**13** And, behold, two of them went that same day to a village called Emmaus, which was from Jerusalem about threescore furlongs.

**14** And they talked together of all these things which had happened.

**15** And it came to pass, that, while they communed together and reasoned, Jesus himself drew near, and went with them.

**16** But their eyes were holden that they should not know him.

**17** And he said unto them, What manner of communications are these that ye have one to another, as ye walk, and are sad?

**18** And the one of them, whose name was Cleopas, answering said unto him, Art thou only a stranger in Jerusalem, and hast not known the things which are come to pass there in these days?

**19** And he said unto them, What things? And they said unto him, Concerning Jesus of Nazareth, which was a prophet mighty in deed and word before God and all the people:

**20** And how the chief priests and our rulers delivered him to be condemned to death, and have crucified him.

**21** But we trusted that it had been he which should have redeemed Israel: and beside all this, to day is the third day since these things were done.

**22** Yea, and certain women also of our company made us astonished, which were early at the sepulchre;

**23** And when they found not his body, they came, saying, that they had also seen a vision of angels, which said that he was alive.

**24** And certain of them which were with us went to the sepulchre, and found it even so as the women had said: but him they saw not.

**25** Then he said unto them, O fools, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken:

**26** Ought not Christ to have suffered these things, and to enter into his glory?

**27** And beginning at Moses and all the prophets, he expounded unto them in all the scriptures the things concerning himself.

**28** And they drew nigh unto the village, whither they went: and he made as though he would have gone further.

**29** But they constrained him, saying, Abide with us: for it is toward evening, and the day is far spent. And he went in to tarry with them.

**30** And it came to pass, as he sat at meat with them, he took bread, and blessed it, and brake, and gave to them.

**31** And their eyes were opened, and they knew him; and he vanished out of their sight.
