**Sermon Text: Mark 1:40-45**

***The Disobedient Leper***

\*\*\*\*\*

**Mark 1:40** And there came a leper to him, beseeching him, and kneeling down to him, and saying unto him, If thou wilt, thou canst make me clean.

**:41** And Jesus, moved with compassion, put forth his hand, and touched him, and saith unto him, I will; be thou clean.

**:42** And as soon as he had spoken, immediately the leprosy departed from him, and he was cleansed.

**:43** And he straitly charged him, and forthwith sent him away;

**:44** And saith unto him, See thou say nothing to any man: but go thy way, shew thyself to the priest, and offer for thy cleansing those things which Moses commanded, for a testimony unto them.

**:45** But he went out, and began to publish it much, and to blaze abroad the matter, insomuch that Jesus could no more openly enter into the city, but was without in desert places: and they came to him from every quarter.

10 Then came the word of the LORD unto Samuel, saying,

11 It repenteth me that I have set up Saul to be king: for he is turned back from following me, and hath not performed my commandments. And it grieved Samuel; and he cried unto the LORD all night.

23 For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness is as iniquity and idolatry. ***Because thou hast rejected the word of the LORD, he hath also rejected thee from being king.***
