Mark 5:14 And they that fed the swine fled, and told it in the city, and in the country. And they went out to see what it was that was done.

:15 And they come to Jesus, and see him that was possessed with the devil, and had the legion, sitting, and clothed, and in his right mind: and they were afraid.

:16 And they that saw it told them how it befell to him that was possessed with the devil, and also concerning the swine.

:17 And they began to pray him to depart out of their coasts.

:18 And when he was come into the ship, he that had been possessed with the devil prayed him that he might be with him.

:19 Howbeit Jesus suffered him not, but saith unto him, Go

home to thy friends, and tell them how great things the Lord hath done for thee, and hath had compassion on thee.

:20 And he departed, and began to publish in Decapolis how great things Jesus had done for him: and all men did marvel.



The Lord Jesus will not stay where he is not wanted. When the people of the country of the Gadarenes heard how the man possessed with the devil had been cured, ***and also concerning the swine, they began to pray him to depart out of their coasts.***

So Jesus got into the boat with his disciples, pushed off from shore, and began to go back across the Sea of Galilee. And we can't help but think of the saying—"You had better watch out what you wish for. You just might get it!"
