We Will Remember

4: Draw me, we will run after thee: the king hath brought me into his chambers: we will be glad and rejoice in thee, **we will remember thy love more than wine: the upright love thee.**

Memory is an amazing thing. But it can be either a blessing or a curse. It all depends.

If my computer is giving me the correct information, the word "**remember**" occurs 148 times in the KJV of the Holy Bible.

The **Lord God** has a memory. And there are many things that he will remember. But thankfully there are also some things which he promises he will not remember.

The **children of the Devil** also have memories. But there are many things that they forget in their lives on this earth. There are also some things that they will remember in the afterlife. Many of these things they will wish that they could forget. But they won't be able to.

The **elect children of God** also have memories. And there are things which the Lord God commands us to remember. There are other things which, especially in the life to come, by the grace of God we will not remember.
