13. A bundle of myrrh is my well-beloved unto me; he shall lie all night betwixt my breasts.




Myrrh Incense

Even the ears of the littlest ones in our congregation perk up at the mention of **myrrh**. And for all of us, the first thing we think of would be the words of Matthew 2:11—“And when they were come into the house, they saw the young child with Mary his mother, and fell down, and worshipped him: and when they had opened their treasures, they presented unto him gifts; gold, and frankincense, and **myrrh**.”

In verse 12 of Song of Solomon chapter 1 the Bride presents to her Husband/King her **spikenard** sending forth a pleasant smell. Now here in verse 13 the Bridegroom presents himself to his Bride as “a bundle of **myrrh**.”

Again, we are standing here on resurrection ground. And these verses are comforting to us beyond words.

Let’s pray for the guidance of the Holy Spirit, and ponder these precious words which He has for us.
