Our House & Our Rafters

17. The beams of our house are cedar, and our rafters of fir.

Cedar & Fir Trees

It is interesting, and extremely instructive, that ***Cedar and Fir Trees*** are mentioned here in the final verse of Song of Solomon 1. And both are mentioned in connection with the ***House***, which is the dwelling place of the ***Bridegroom and His Bride!***

Both the ***Cedar and Fir Trees*** were used in the construction of what we generally call ***Solomon's Temple***. Hiram the king of Tyre furnished Solomon with ***cedar trees and fir trees***, and with gold, according to all his desire. I Kings 9:11.

Of special meaning here are the words of our Lord Jesus in John 14:1-3. "Let not your heart be troubled . . . In my Father's house are many mansions . . . I go to prepare a place for you . . . I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also." Let us pray for the guidance of the Holy Spirit as we ponder this final verse of Song of Solomon chapter one—a verse which is comforting beyond words.
