Sermon Text: Song Of Solomon 2:7

Till He Please

Song of Solomon 2:7 I charge you, O ye daughters of Jerusalem, by the roes, and by the hinds of the field, that ye stir not up, nor awake *my* love, till he please.

Daughters of Jerusalem

This is not the first time we have heard of the ***daughters of Jerusalem*** here in the book of Song Of Solomon. Nor will it be the last time. Because of the importance of this mysterious group of people, let us see what the Holy Spirit tells us of them.

Facts concerning the daughters of Jerusalem:

The phrase ***daughters of Jerusalem*** occurs eight times in the KJV of the Bible. Seven of these times it occurs in the Old Testament. And all seven of the occurrences are in Song Of Solomon. One time the phrase occurs in the New Testament.

The eight occurrences of ***“daughters of Jerusalem”***:

Song of Solomon:

1:5

2:7

3:5

3:10

5:8

5:16

8:4

Gospel of Luke: 23:28

Four times in Song Of Solomon the Bride ***charges (commands)*** the daughters of Jerusalem. (2:7, 3:5, 5:8, 8:4.) One time the daughters of Jerusalem repeat the word ***“charge”*** in question form. (5:9). Five is the number of *grace* in Scripture.
