

Sermon Text: Song Of Solomon 2:13

Figs & Grapes

Song of Solomon 2:13a The fig tree putteth forth her green figs, and the vines with the tender grape give a good smell.

The ***fig tree*** is a common thing in Scripture, and references to it are found from Genesis to Revelation. Sometimes the references are used in a good sense, other times in an evil sense.

One reference which is especially important to us this morning is found in Matthew 24:32-33.

Matthew 24:32 Now learn a parable of the fig tree; When his branch is yet tender, and putteth forth leaves, ye know that summer is nigh:

Matthew 24:33 So likewise ye, when ye shall see all these things, know that it is near, even at the doors.



Vineyards are also mentioned often in Scripture, especially in the Old Testament. We will meet with several references here in the Song Of Solomon.
