Sermon Text: Song Of Solomon 1 & 2

An Overview

This morning we are going to pause, and take a little look at the verses we have studied so far in Song of Solomon. That would include the following: 1:1 – 2:13.

After that, we'll take a little peek at some of the material the Holy Spirit will set before us in the rest of this very special Book of Holy Scripture.

One of the references from Scripture that we will pay close attention to is found in Matthew 1:18-25. We will print them here for easy reference:

The Birth of Jesus

Matthew 1:18-25

18 Now the birth of Jesus Christ was on this wise: When as his mother Mary was ***espoused to Joseph, before they came together,*** she was ***found with child*** of the Holy Ghost.

19 Then Joseph her husband, being a just man, and not willing to make her a publick example, was minded to ***put her away privily.***

20 But while he thought on these things, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared unto him in a dream, saying, Joseph, thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee ***Mary thy wife:*** for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost.

21 And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins.

22 Now all this was done, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken of the Lord by the prophet, saying,

23 Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us.

24 Then Joseph being raised from sleep did as the angel of the Lord had bidden him, ***and took unto him his wife:***

25 And knew her not till she had brought forth her firstborn son: and he called his name JESUS.
