**Sermon Text: Song Of Solomon 3:10**

***Silver, Gold, & Purple***

\*\*\*\*\*

**Song of Solomon 3:10 He made the pillars thereof of silver, the bottom thereof of gold, the covering of it of purple, the midst thereof being paved with love, for the daughters of Jerusalem.**



In the opening verses of Genesis 13 the Holy Spirit tells us: Genesis 13:1 And Abram went up out of Egypt, he, and his wife, and all that he had, and Lot with him, into the south. :2 And Abram was very rich in cattle, in **silver**, and in **gold**. Very early in history these two metals were counted as being very precious. Same is true even today.



It is no surprise to us, then, that we find both **silver** and **gold** used in the construction of Solomon’s Chariot. ***“He made the pillars thereof of silver, the bottom thereof of gold.”*** Both **silver** and **gold** have special spiritual connotations in Scripture. We’ll look at some of them this morning.

The Holy Spirit also mentions concerning Solomon’s Chariot that ***“the covering of it (was) of purple.”*** This information is precious beyond words. We’ll take a special look at the color ***“purple”*** this morning.

And finally, everything mentioned in this verse is ***“paved with love.”*** And this ***“love”*** is offered to ***“the daughters of Jerusalem.”***

Here we can’t help but think of John 3:16! ***“For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.”***
