Sermon Text: Song Of Solomon 4:1b

Her Hair--Goats

Song of Solomon 4:1b ***Thy hair is as a flock of goats, that appear from mount Gilead.***

Son 4:1b your hair [makes me think of the black, wavy fleece] of a flock of [the Arabian] goats which one sees trailing down Mount Gilead [beyond the Jordan on the frontiers of the desert]. The Amplified Bible

The first thing the Bridegroom mentions about the beauty of his Bride is her **eyes**. Now the second thing he mentions is her **hair**.

The Bride's hair is compared to ***a flock of goats, that appear from mount Gilead.***



A related passage in the New Testament would be selected verses from I Corinthians 11. For reference:

1 Corinthians 11:7 For a man indeed ought not to cover his head, forasmuch as he is the image and glory of God: but the woman is the glory of the man.

:8 For the man is not of the woman; but the woman of the man.

:9 Neither was the man created for the woman; but the woman for the man.

:10 For this cause ought the woman to have power on her head because of the angels.

:11 Nevertheless neither is the man without the woman, neither the woman without the man, in the Lord.

:12 For as the woman is of the man, even so is the man also by the woman; but all things of God.

:13 Judge in yourselves: is it comely that a woman pray unto God uncovered?

:14 Doth not even nature itself teach you, that, if a man have long hair, it is a shame unto him?

11:15 But if a woman have long hair, it is a glory to her: for her hair is given her for a covering.
