**Sermon Text: Song Of Solomon 4:7**

***No Spot In Thee***

\*\*\*\*\*

**Song of Solomon 4:7 Thou art all fair, my love; there is no spot in thee.**

\*\*\*\*\*

What we have here in this precious verse is an amazing miracle! ***The Bridegroom*** (Jesus Christ), in praising the ***flawless beauty of his Bride*** (the true Church), says of her—***Thou art all fair, my love; there is no spot in thee!***

This is not the picture that the Holy Spirit paints of the Bride of Christ in Romans 7.

**Romans 7:14** For we know that the law is spiritual: but I am carnal, sold under sin.

:15 For that which I do I allow not: for what I would, that do I not; but what I hate, that do I.

:16 If then I do that which I would not, I consent unto the law that it is good.

:17 Now then it is no more I that do it, but sin that dwelleth in me.

:18 For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh,) dwelleth no good thing: for to will is present with me; but how to perform that which is good I find not.

:19 For the good that I would I do not: but the evil which I would not, that I do.

:20 Now if I do that I would not, it is no more I that do it, but sin that dwelleth in me.

:21 I find then a law, that, when I would do good, evil is present with me.

:22 For I delight in the law of God after the inward man:

:23 But I see another law in my members, warring against the law of my mind, and bringing me into captivity to the law of sin which is in my members.

:24 O wretched man that I am! who shall deliver me from the body of this death?

:25 I thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord. So then with the mind I myself serve the law of God; but with the flesh the law of sin.

What a transformation we have here! Talk about going from rags to riches!

See here the amazing value of ***the blood of Jesus Christ!*** And also, the equally amazing ***power of the Holy Spirit and His Word!*** And while we are at it, the equally amazing ***love of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit toward the Bride of the Son of God!***
