Sermon Text: Song Of Solomon 5:1

I Am Come!

Song of Solomon 5:1 I am come into my garden, my sister, my spouse: I have gathered my myrrh with my spice; I have eaten my honeycomb with my honey; I have drunk my wine with my milk: eat, O friends; drink, yea, drink abundantly, O beloved.

The first miracle Jesus performed during his years on this earth was when he turned **water into wine**. Fittingly, this miracle took place at a **marriage** in Cana of Galilee. John 2:1-11.

Notice the connection here in Song Of Solomon between 4:15 and 5:1.

In 4:15 **water** is present in abundance. The Bride is described as being “a **fountain** of gardens, a well of **living waters**, and **streams** from Lebanon.” Now here in 5:1 the Bridegroom has come into his garden. And he says—“I have drunk my **wine** with my milk.” And he invites his Bride to “**Drink! Yea, drink abundantly!**”



The theme has changed from **water to wine!** And the truth, as the poet writes: “**Grow old along with me! The best is yet to be!**”
