Sermon Text: Song Of Solomon 5:4

The Hand Of God

Song of Solomon 5:4 My beloved put in his hand by the hole of the door, and my bowels were moved for him.

We have in this verse an amazing miracle! Consider the Bride of Christ as the Holy Spirit records for us in Song Of Solomon 5:2-3:

2 ***I sleep***, but my heart waketh: it is the voice of my beloved that knocketh, saying, Open to me, my sister, my love, my dove, my undefiled: for my head is filled with dew, and my locks with the drops of the night. 3 ***I have put off my coat; how shall I put it on? I have washed my feet; how shall I defile them?***

But now what a change has taken place! ***My bowels were moved for him!*** And it was all brought about by the Bridegroom! ***My beloved put in his hand by the hole of the door!***



In Scripture the ***hand of God*** often speaks of his ***power***.

Exodus 15:6 Thy right hand, O LORD, is become glorious in power: thy right hand, O LORD, hath dashed in pieces the enemy.

Acts 11:21 And the hand of the Lord was with them: and a great number believed, and turned unto the Lord.

What we have here is a miracle performed by the Son of God and the Holy Spirit! It is performed on the heart of the Bride of Christ. She had nothing to do with it. The miracle was performed *on* her, but not *by* her.
