**Sermon Text: Song Of Solomon 6:3**

***Eternal Election***

**Song of Solomon 6:3 I am my beloved's, and my beloved is mine:  
he feedeth among the lilies.**

The first marriage in history took place in the Garden of Eden. The Holy Spirit has recorded the event for us in **Genesis 2**. Selected verses:

7 And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul. 8 And the LORD God planted a garden eastward in Eden; and there he put the man whom he had formed.

18 And the LORD God said, It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him an help meet for him.

21 And the LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall upon Adam, and he slept: and he took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh instead thereof;

22 And the rib, which the LORD God had taken from man, made he a woman, and brought her unto the man.

23 And Adam said, This is now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh: she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man.

24 Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh.



The last marriage in history will also take place in a Garden. Only this marriage speaks better things than did the marriage in Eden's Garden. Song Of Solomon 6:2-3. 2 My beloved is gone down into his garden, to the beds of spices, to feed in the gardens, and to gather lilies.

3 I am my beloved's, and my beloved is mine: he feedeth among the lilies.
